1 SECTION 1. “The Saint Lawrence state asylum for the insane” as the same
2 was authorized to be established by chapter three hundred and seventy-five
3 of the laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-seven, shall hereafter be known
4 and designated as “the Saint Lawrence state hospital.”

1 § 2. All acts or parts of acts relating to “the Saint Lawrence state asylum
2 for the insane” are hereby made applicable to “the Saint Lawrence state
3 hospital.”

1 § 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
